#### *Study Questions:*

1. What does the word sacrifice mean to you and what does it mean to be a living sacrifice? Does a sacrifice exist for a moment or how long does it last?
2. Our presenter highlights the importance of 'Mercy' over ambition and legalism. Why does mercy make a difference in relationships?
3. What does transformation mean to you? Is it bad or good? Paul suggests the moments we live in may seek to constrict us, as followers of Jesus. How do we stay open to being transformed by new wisdom or God's priorities for us?
4. In our video we're asked to reflect on the connection of body and mind. What the mind focuses on, the body will feed by. Do we let Christ and his Gospel share all our thoughts and focus our priorities? If not, why?
5. Paul urges us to have as our purpose, to draw all together in union with Christ. That the world may have faith in his love and gifts for all. How do we transform our lives to draw strength from Jesus for this work and also, labour to do this?
