
Week 3 Topic: Romans Chapter 2 to Chapter 3:20

Study Questions:

- 1. Dr. Defazio suggests Paul's motivation for Romans was to restore the people of Rome to a state of grace, by introducing them to the Gospel. What does it take to hear and receive this Gospel Paul speaks about?
- 2. How do we let a judge sit over us? Do we understand the purpose of the law?
- 3. When all, even the 'chosen nation', fail to live up to the law, what does God do?
- 4. What did the Jew's assume was their role and how did they treat it in Paul's time? How do we relate to this today as Christians?
- 5. What is the significance of verse 3:10? "None Righteous, not even one."
- 6. St. Paul suggests our expression of sin is often revealed in how we treat and speak to people. How are we doing at this?
