Week 4 Topic: Romans Chapter 3:21 to Chapter 4

Study Questions:

- Roman's opening has been harsh. We now explore the desires of God's heart. What are God's desires and how does God seek to bring them about?
- 2. Jesus is the propitiation for our sins (*Romans 3:25*). What does this mean to you?
- 3. God is Holy, Faithful and Just. This is God's character. Romans tells how Jesus died as an offering for our sins. Should God have compromised God's values and prevented Christ's death?
- 4. In ch. 4, how do the saints of the Old Testament live out their faith? How do we?
- 5. Abraham was righteous without works or the law (4:9-11). What does this tell us?
- 6. How do Abraham and David understand their relationship with God? What would it look like to have the faith of Abraham and David?
