## Study Questions:

- 3. Who did Jesus die for and why did he die? Do we see his death as a personal gift for us or is it a concept that we understand?
- 4. What does it mean to be "Saved by his life"? Romans 5: 10
- 5. What does it mean that we cannot save ourselves? How do we feel about this?
- 6. God loved us while still sinners. Does God through Jesus love us more or differently if we enter into a personal relationship with Jesus?
