Study Questions:

- 1. How important is the Old Testament to you? Is the OT Law a bad thing?
- 2. What does it mean to not live in the letter but the Spirit? Romans 7:7
- 3. Does the law accomplish or fulfil an aim, or is something else needed to accomplish the aim a law points to?
- 4. Paul hints at his former self, before turning to Christ and how the zeal for the letter drove him further from God's desires for His Children. What does Paul want us to learn from his experience here?
- 5. What does it mean that we should not be walking according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit?
- 6. Our video, says that the gentile experience of coming to know Christ, resembles the Jewish liberation from Pharaoh. Our struggle to embrace this liberation can resemble the resettling of Israel in the Promised Land. *Can you trust and follow?*
